

A Different Way of Thinking:

- Magic, comedy, and storytelling about what being autistic is like
- Attendees will be entertained while seeing Cody's challenges and coping strategies throughout his life
- Great for public outreach

Sensory Friendly Spectacular:

- Cody removes loud noises, bright lights, and complex plots.....without removing the fun!
- Being disabled himself, Cody understands how to engage everyone at the level they're comfortable with.

TALKS (AND SOME TRICKS)

My lived experiences with autism give me an expertise in many subjects disabled people and their service providers find important. This allows me to offer four unique talks (with tricks to keep it spicy) which help disabled people gain important life skills and assist service providers in effectively serving their students.

Dis-Impos-Ability

Attendees will learn what important figures like my speech/occupational therapists, school teachers, and parents did & didn't do well early on. That way, service providers can see how they can help disabled people succeed.

Revealing the Secrets Behind Essential Skills

Attendees will learn core life skills in self, people, and emotional management which will help them become successful employees and adults!

Self Employment in Your Special Interest

Knowing that many disabled people find self-employment appealing, Cody shares an honest look behind the scenes of his business. Attendees will see what it takes to develop a special interest based business and can decide if it's right for them.

Making Life Magical

Attendees will enrich their lives by learning how to discover interests, connect to communities/build friendships, and work through fears of trying new things.
